« High risk chemical facilities and risk mitigation in the African Atlantic Façade » to the European Union Initiative of Centers of Excellence for CBRN risk reduction.

Develop Capacities and improve Chemical Risk Management in the West African Region in order to:

Prevent the occurrence of major risks (accidents and/or pollution) in and outside the installations containing chemicals.

Respond quickly and appropriately in the event of a chemical incident, to limit the impact on human health and the environment, and resume normal activity (to preserve economic activity and employment)

INERIS and INERIS Development co-perform with Expertise France the following services:

CWP1: Provide technical assistance to update the legal framework for the management of high-risk industrial installations based on European directives IED and SEVESO3 and CIPE (Classified Installations for the Protection of the Environment).

CWP 2 : Provide technical assistance to update the legal framework for the management of high-risk industrial installations based on European directives IED and SEVESO3 and ICPE (Classified Installations for the Protection of the Environment).

CWP 3 : Technically support the actions carried out by the regional team in each country by developing in particular an e-learning platform and the feasibility study of a university-level diploma training to ensure the sustainability of the achievements.
